

BOTTLED WATER FOR EMERGENCIES

In Case Of Emergencies, Bottled Water May Be Needed!

- U Store bottled water for your family. Have available enough water for 7 days. You will need about 1 gallon of water per person per day.
- U Store bottled water in clean containers (plastic milk jugs). Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- U Mark the date on the bottle when you fill it. Replace the water every 6 months.
