Have a person pick one of the Spanish speaking countries from the list above and not tell anyone the country they picked. Have that person locate it on the map without showing anyone. Then let that person give clues to the participants so they can guess the name of the country and its location.

- Clue Suggestions:**
- describe the shape of the country (ex. shaped like a sock)
  - name other countries that border it
  - rhyme the countries name with another word
  - name its capital

The first player to correctly guess the country selects the next country.

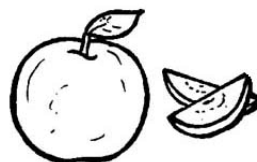
